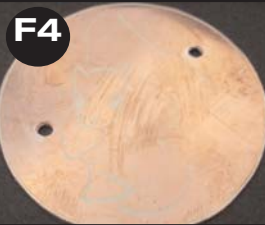
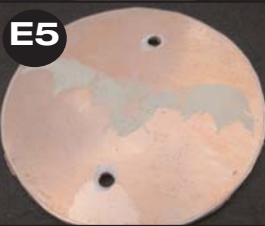


COPPER TRAIL – FACTSHEET

Here are some of the trees, mammals and creatures of the night that you can find on the Copper Trail. The middle column shows you the symbol to look for on the Trail, together with some information about them.

squirrel	1  Wikimedia Commons	F4 	I am a rodent but humans like me. I eat nuts, seeds and bury acorns to eat in the winter. I am great at climbing trees but damage them.
bat	2  Rauhautfledermaus	E5 	I appear about dusk and fly by echolocation. In one night I can eat thousands of insects. I help to pollinate plants and spread seeds.
owl	3  P Milner	C7 	I am a night-time bird of prey. I have big eyes and great eyesight so I can hunt small mammals and insects. I am said to be wise.
sycamore	4  P Milner	C6 	I am very common and my seeds are often called helicopters. I lose my leaves in winter. I will grow almost anywhere.
fox	5  Wikimedia Commons	B6 	I am a mammal related to the dog. I leave a strong smell to mark my territory. I eat mostly anything and am starting to live in the city.
deer	6  R Raul	B3 	I am a larger mammal. I am herbivorous (vegetarian). Males are called 'buck' and females are called 'doe'.
sweet chestnut	7  P Milner	C3 	I bear edible fruits in autumn and lose my leaves in winter. My fruits are roasted and used in stuffing, especially at Christmas.
