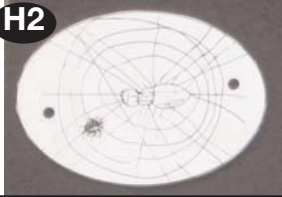


ZINC TRAIL – FACTSHEET

Here are some of the creepy, poisonous or sweet things that you can find on the Zinc Trail. The middle column shows you the symbol to look for on the Trail, together with some information about it.

slow worm	1  Dave Green	C3 	I am a reptile sometimes called a legless lizard. I eat slugs, worms, spiders and insects. I like the sun, but also like to hide under things.
spider	2  Duk	H2 	I am most obvious in autumn. I hide in tunnels I spin and I also make webs to trap my food. I eat butterflies, wasps and flies.
peacock	3  Titus Tscharnke	H3 	I pretend to have big eyes to scare predators such as mice. I like full sun and take the nectar provided by plants like honeysuckle.
brimstone	4  Sarefo	G4 	Like other butterflies around here, I am good at camouflage. I feed on nectar, especially from purple flowers such as heather.
comma	5  Susan A-C	F5 	I am tatty around the edges and get my name from a white mark under my wing like a comma. I need nettles to thrive.
honeysuckle	6  Bilou	D5 	I am sometimes known as wood-bine. I smell very sweet and attract all sorts of flying insects with my delicious nectar.
grasshopper	7  Nat Edwards	B5 	My antenna are shorter than my body. I make sounds by rubbing my legs against my wings. I like to eat grasses and leaves.
ladybird	8  Gaudete	B5 	I am a beetle. My wings are bright red, orange or yellow with black spots. I can be a pest but I help by eating (aphids) greenfly.
fungi	9  Anemone Projectors	A4 	My name is fly agaric and I am posionous, like many of my fellow fungi. I like shady, cool places. I am eaten by squirrels and rodents.
